MAIN DECISIONS

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING - FRIDAY 10 SEPTEMBER 2021

The Executive Council met today under the Chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Louis Serge CLAIR, G.C.S.K.

1. The Executive Council has agreed to the activities being organised by the Commission for Tourism to mark the World Tourism Day 2021 which will be celebrated on Monday 27 September 2021 on the theme "Tourism for Inclusive Growth":
 - i. Mass at Chapelle Saint Marc, Songes on Saturday 25 September 2021; and
 - ii. Launching of mobile application for promotion and marketing of Rodrigues as a tourist destination by the Rodrigues Tourism Office on Monday 27 September 2021.
2. ✓ The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission of Housing will hand over letters of pre-selection to 143 potential beneficiaries for the upgrading and extension of Trust Fund houses scheme and the new social housing scheme.
3. The Executive Council has agreed that the Commission for Education provides:
 - i. An additional grant to the Development and Learning Centre for Disabled Children to meet the salary of a Carer; and
 - ii. A Grant-in-Aid to Special Needs Education (SEN) Schools to operate the Supplementary Programme in Rodrigues.

4. The Executive Council has agreed that the Commission for Industrial Development launches the Technology and Acquisition Modernisation Scheme (TAMS) to help Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) modernise the products and services being offered through new technologies and equipment.
5. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Family Welfare proceeds with upgrading works at the Shelter *Marie Reine de la Croix*, Baladirou to facilitate its registration with the Residential Care Home Board.
6. ✓ The Executive Council has agreed that the Commission for Vocational Training provides a grant to Polytechnics Mauritius LTD (PML) for the setting up of a Polytechnics Mauritius Campus at Citron Donis in October 2021.
7. The Executive Council has taken note of the outcome of the 22nd meeting of the Rodrigues Tourism Licensing Committee held on the 03 September 2021.
8. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Sports will launch procurement exercise for:
 - i. upgrading works at Vanguard Volleyball pitch and Terre Rouge Sports Complex; and
 - ii. construction of New *Centre de Lecture et d'Animation Culturelle* (CLAC) at Port Sud Est
9. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Sports in collaboration with the Rodrigues Regional Regatta Association will organise a Regatta League in Rodrigues which will be launched on Sunday 19 September 2021.
10. The Executive Council has taken note that the books compiled in connection with the project "*Rakont Nou Lavi Lontan*" will be launched on Wednesday 15 September 2021. The project based on the collection of oral stories from the elderly was being implemented jointly by the Commission for Arts and Culture and the Rodrigues College.
