



RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 15 May 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land proceeds with the fast track procedures to give priority to eligible Rodriguan professional for the grant of residential state land lease.
- (ii) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Education will provide a grant to the Rodrigues Educational Development Company (REDCO) for several Capital Projects.
- (iii) To approve that the Commission for Trade Licences proceeds with the issue of some Trade Licences pending amendment and subletting of the leases as appropriate and to refer the cases to the Cadastral Office for processing and finalisation of the appropriate commercial leases.
- (iv) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the issuance of Reservation Letters to applicants for Agricultural Permits whose applications have been found favourable.
- (v) That the Commission for Agriculture will give authorisation to the Ministry of Housing and Lands to conduct a Hydrographic Survey in Rodrigues.

- (vi) To approve that the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the issuance of a permit of research to the Associate Professor of the University of Mauritius to collect Marine and Environment Samples.
- (vii) That the Commission for Social Security will proceed with the provision of commode wheelchairs to some beneficiaries, in need of such equipment, to support their daily living activities.
- (viii) That the Commission for Social Security proceeds with the procurement of Fowler beds with Ripple Mattresses for persons with disabilities and elderly persons, to enhance the comfort, dignity and quality of life of the most vulnerable members of the society.
- (ix) To approve that the Commission for Housing will proceed with the provision of housing units to some vulnerable families under the Infrastructure Development for Needy Family Scheme, refund of construction materials to a beneficiary and provide construction materials to a fire victim under the New Social Housing Scheme, all on humanitarian ground.
- (x) That the Commission for Handicraft will proceed with the holding of a local fair from 28th to 30th May 2026 at Port Mathurin in the context of the Mother's Day Celebration.
- (xi) To approve that the Commission for Tourism will provide support to the Chung San Society for its participation in the 18th Edition of the Dragon Boat Festival to be held on 14th June 2026, at Le Caudan Waterfront, Mauritius.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) Of the official visit of a delegation of the Embassy of the People's Republic of China led by the Minister Counsellor Mr DING Peiyi from 17th to 19th May 2026, in Rodrigues.
- (ii) That a delegation from the National Agency for Drug Control (NADC) will be on mission to Rodrigues from 24th to 28th May 2026.
- (iii) That a delegation of the Financial Crimes Commission will be on mission to Rodrigues from 18th to 22nd May 2026, in view of further consolidation of its partnership and efforts to fight against financial crimes.

- (iv) Of the holding of Vision 50 Regional and Thematic Consultation for Rodrigues during the first week of June 2026 so as to capture the priorities, aspirations and challenges of the population of Rodrigues.
- (v) That the Commission for Education will initiate action to advertise Scholarships offered by the Rodrigues Regional Assembly for Academic Year 2026-2027.
- (vi) That at its meeting held on 12th May 2026, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of twenty-one (21) Residential Building and Land Use Permit.
- (vii) That at its meeting held on 7th May 2026, the Licensing Committee has approved thirty-two (32) applications for the issue of Trade Licence.
- (viii) That the Commission for Health, in collaboration with the NCD Secretariat and Health Promotion Unit will proceed with the organisation of a one (1) day activity at Eau Claire Playing Ground on 17th May 2026 from 09:30 a.m. to 14.00 p.m. to mark the World Hypertension Day under the theme "*Controlling Hypertension Together!*".
- (ix) Of the activities to be organised by the Commission for Health on 16th May 2026 to mark the Commemoration of AIDS Candlelight 2026 at Monument de L'espoir , Mont Lubin and Petit Gabriel Community Centre.
- (x) That the Commission for Family Welfare will proceed with the award of contract for the setting up of a Family Resources and Wellness Centre at Pointe Venus.
- (xi) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will provide a financial assistance to a cultural group for its participation in the Indian Ocean Music Market (IOMMa) and Festival Sakifo in Reunion Island from 2nd to 6th June 2026.
