



RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 22 May 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will put at the disposal of MFR a building at Saint Gabriel for education purposes.
- (ii) To approve in principle that the Chief Commissioner's Office, initiates procedures and necessary arrangement to enable the disbursement of a grant to the Vicariat Apostolique de Rodrigues for the setting up of a '*Maison de Retraite & Unite de Repit*' at La Ferme in view of providing a safe place, specific attention and community support to elderly persons in Rodrigues.
- (iii) That the Commission for Education will provide a grant to the Rodrigues Education Development Company (REDCO) Ltd for the organisation of Intercollegiate Athletics 2026 and for participation of the athletes in Mauritius.
- (iv) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office will proceed with the payment to the Central Electricity Board (CEB) for the installation of the three-phase electricity meters at the Point Coton Desalination Plant and associated pumping stations at Pointe Coton and Mt Piquant under the Primary Water Transfer Network Project.

- (v) To approve that the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will proceed with the recruitment of an Accountant, to strengthen the financial management and administrative capacity of the company.
- (vi) That the Commission for Cooperative will proceed with the relaunching of St Gabriel Co-operative Store Society Ltd, serving the whole population of Rodrigues and contributing towards economic development, price stabilisation and promotion of local entrepreneurship.
- (vii) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the implementation of the Phytosanitary (pesticide) Products and Seed Subsidy Scheme to support planters, enhance crop protection, productivity and agricultural output during the Cropping Season 2026.
- (viii) That the Commission for Housing will proceed with the refund of openings works in favour of some beneficiaries under the New Social Housing Scheme.
- (ix) That a delegation from the Commission for Tourism will participate in the VEEZIT International Indian Ocean Tourism Fair and the 1st Edition of the Best Travel Agency Award in Reunion Island from 5th to 7th June 2026.
- (x) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will grant authorisation to an event organiser for the organisation of a concert at Mourouk Anse Anfer Football Ground on 1st August 2026.
- (xi) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will grant permission to a Village Committee to organise a mini concert at L'Union Football Ground on 28th June 2026 to raise fund for the procurement and repairs of furniture and equipment for the community centre.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That a delegation from the European Union will be on mission to Rodrigues from 31st May to 5th June 2026 in connection with the Technical Assistance for the strengthening and operationalisation of Institutional Coordination mechanism for the implementation of the SIDPR 2023-2032.
- (ii) Of the organisation of training courses for Officers of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly in view of enhancing their knowledges and developing the skills and competencies for effective, efficient and prompt delivering of services.

- (iii) That the Commission for Education will proceed with the re-launching of bids for the Upgrading and Rehabilitation Works at two (2) Primary Government Schools.
- (iv) That the Commission for Public Infrastructure will proceed with the award of contract for the Demolition and Reconstruction of Bus Shelters at Port Mathurin Bus Terminal.
- (v) That the Commission for Public Infrastructure will proceed with the handing over of polyethylene water tanks of 5m³ to some beneficiaries.
- (vi) Of the implementation of the Land Mechanisation Scheme Cropping Season from January to 15th December 2026 to boost crop production.
- (vii) That the Commission for Forestry will proceed with the restoration of forests land through the Community and End-User Participation Procurement Method.
- (viii) That the Commission for Fire Services has proceeded with the award of contract to a company for the supply, delivery and commissioning of a First Response Pickup Van and for the installation and programming of Repeater Stations for the Fire and Rescue Services.
- (ix) Of the holding of training of Artisans in creative Crafts by the Academy of Design and Innovation (ADI) from 25th May to 19th June 2026.
- (x) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will proceed with the organisation of recreational activities for people with disabilities , *Ti Zenfan Gran Talan and Program lamer ek lanatir* in collaboration with the Mauritius Recreation Council (MRC) in Rodrigues from 25th to 29th May 2026.
- (xi) Of the organisation of Bronze and Silver Award presentations of certificates and medals in colleges in the context of The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award.
- (xii) Of the activities to be organised by the Commission for Arts and Culture to mark the World Music Day Celebrations 2026.
