MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 14 August 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Commission for Education will mount a Skills Training Programme in Computer Studies and IT Support (CRAITS) for some out of school youth to be run by Wisdom in Tech Co.Ltd.
- (ii) That the Commission for Fisheries will proceed with the processing of applications for training in Off- Lagoon Fishing.
- (iii) That the Commission for Fisheries will proceed with the redeployment of fishers involved in the Alternative Livelihood Programme to the Surveillance Team and enlistment of new Supervisors to ensure effective surveillance at sea with regard to the 2nd Octopus Closed Season 2026.
- (iv) To approve the adjustment of the monthly stipend payable to the Community Health Agents in term of recognition for their contribution to the health and well-being of the population.
- (v) That the Commission for Housing will proceed with the modification in the design of the new corrugated iron sheet houses whereby the conventional inclined pitched roof will be replaced with an inclined roof in zinc aluminium sheets.

- (vi) To agree in principle for the setting up and appointment of Members of a Management Committee of the Probation Home for Girls and the Probation Hostel for Boys in Rodrigues subject to approval of the Prime Minister's Office.
- (vii) To approve the publication and commercialisation of the 2nd Edition of the 'Diksioner Kreol Rodrige'.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office will proceed with the enlistment of new interns under the Service to Mauritius (STM) Programme.
- (ii) That the Commission for Environment will proceed with the programme of activities to commemorate the World Ozone Day from 14th to 18th September 2026 under the theme '*Global Action for a Cooler Planet*'.
- (iii) That the Commission for Education will proceed with the inauguration of the Gymnasium at Terre Rouge College on Friday 21st August 2026.
- (iv) That the Rodrigues Educational Development Company (REDCO) has proceeded with the recruitment of a Warden for the Rodrigues Student House in Mauritius.
- (v) That at its meeting held on 12th August 2026, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of nine (9) Residential Building and Land Use Permit.
- (vi) That the Commission for Health will proceed with the installation of eight (8) new Condom Vending Machines in Rodrigues as from 17th August 2026.
