MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 10 July 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will proceed with the grant of a plot of state land to '*Association pour le Développement de la Pêche au Thon à Rodrigues*' for the implementation of its project.
- (ii) That the Commission for State Land will proceed with the allocation of lots in the parcelling zone at Baladirou to some applicants for Residential and Industrial Purposes.
- (iii) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Environment will initiate procedures for the engagement of suitable qualified individuals and/or firms to provide collection, transportation, disposal and recycling services for recyclable wastes namely card boards/paper, glass bottles and metals, light and high density polyethylene items amongst others under the Rodrigues Waste Segregation Initiatives.
- (iv) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will proceed with the handing over of water tanks to some priority beneficiaries under the Rainwater Harvesting Scheme.

- (v) That the Commission for Housing will disburse funding for the provision of housing assistance to some neediest families under the New Social Housing Scheme, Upgrading of Trust Fund, the Infrastructure Development for Needy Families and the Government Grant for Casting/Recasting of Slab Scheme, all on humanitarian ground.
- (vi) That the Commission for Health will proceed with the introduction of the proposed Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Market/Fair) Regulations 2026 to the Regional Assembly at its sitting to be held on 4th August 2026.
- (vii) To approve the activities to be organised by the Commission for Arts and Culture to mark the 24th Anniversary of the Autonomy of Rodrigues.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) Of the organisation of monthly meetings with all Commissions on Annual Work Plan for Financial Year 2026- 2027 for closer monitoring and follow-up on the implementation of budget measures.
- (ii) Of the organisation of a one-day intensive training programme on "Personal Effectiveness" on 21st July 2026 at Antoinette Prudence Human Resource Development Centre (HRDC), Malabar for public officers.
- (iii) That the Commission for Agriculture will collaborate with a veterinary team from Mauritius for the organisation of a free dog sterilization campaign in Rodrigues in September 2026.
- (iv) That the Commission for Price Fixing will proceed with the implementation of the extended Price Stabilization Fund (PSF) Subsidy Scheme.
- (v) Of the participation of a delegation from Rodrigues in the 5th Edition of the 'Festikite Madagascar', which will be held at La Baie de SAKALAVA, Diego-Suarez Antsiranana, from 14th to 16th August 2026.
