



RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 03 July 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chef Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land requests the Commission for Agriculture to immediately process and issue Agricultural Permits to the relocated planters at La Boucherie in the context of the Airport Development Project.
- (ii) To approve the payment of compensation for the loss of fruit trees to some relocated households from Ste Marie and Mt Travers Village.
- (iii) That the Commission for Education will proceed with the organisation of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly Educational Awards 2026 to reward students who excelled at the Primary School Achievement Certificate (PSAC), National Certificate of Education (NCE) and School Certificate (SC) 2025 on 17th July 2026 at Marie Daflarence Edouard Gymnasium, Ananias Andre Le Chou College, Le Chou.
- (iv) That the Commission for Vocational Training will proceed with the revised schemes with respect to financial assistances provided to post-secondary students as from July 2026, in line with the Budget Speech for Financial Year 2026/2027.

- (v) To approve that the Commission for Education reviews the School Feeding Project and adopts new modalities for the provision of meals daily to pre-primary and primary pupils as from the beginning of the third school term, on 17th August 2026.
- (vi) That the Commission for Education proceeds with the provision of financial assistance to secondary schools who will proceed on study tours during Academic Year 2026.
- (vii) That the Commission for Education will hire the services of a Research Oriented Linguist specialising in Creole Studies, lexicography, language policy and linguistic inclusion within the Republic of Mauritius to advise the Rodrigues Regional Assembly on the possibility of introducing Kreol Rodrige (KR) in secondary schools in Rodrigues.
- (viii) To approve that the Rodrigues Educational Development Company Ltd proceeds with the recruitment of a Warden for the Rodrigues Student House in Mauritius.
- (ix) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the implementation of a revised protocol governing the exportation of livestock to Mauritius for the period April to September 2026.
- (x) That the Commission for Cooperatives will provide a financial assistance to a Cooperative Society for the organisation of the International Day for Cooperatives on 4th July 2026 at Baladirou.
- (xi) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will provide a financial assistance to the Port Mathurin Karate Club (PMKC) for the organisation of PMKC International Cup 2026, on 25th and 26th July 2026 at Malabar Gymnasium.
- (xii) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will proceed with the organisation of the Inter Villages Games 2026.
- (xiii) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will provide a financial assistance to a Rodriguan storyteller for his participation in the '*Soubiz Rakontaz*' Regional Storytelling Festival organised by L'Agence KOMKIFO in Reunion island from 2nd to 6th November 2026.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That at its meeting held on 4th June 2026, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of twenty (20) Residential and one (1) Commercial Building and Land Use Permit.
- (ii) That a delegation from the Registrar of Associations will be on mission to Rodrigues from 7th to 11th July 2026.
- (iii) That a delegation from the Ministry of Labour and Industrial Relations will be in Rodrigues from 5th to 11th July 2026 to deliver training to Officers of the Labour Office in the context of the Computerisation of the Labour Division.
