MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 24 July 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Commission for Environment will proceed with the signature of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Rodrigues Public Utilities Corporation to ensure the operational management of the Grenade Waste Water Treatment Plant.
- (ii) To approve consultancy services to the Rodrigues Regional Assembly (RRA) with regard to the conduct of an organizational assessment and training to Departmental Heads and other Senior Staff of the RRA during the months of August and September 2026.
- (iii) That the Commission for Education will proceed with the appointment of a new Director representing the Government of Mauritius on the Board of Directors of the Rodrigues Educational Development Company (REDCO) Ltd.
- (iv) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the implementation of a temporary intervention aimed at supporting local pumpkin, sweet potato and cassava growers to avoid burden of surplus production.
- (v) That the Commission for Fisheries will proceed with the implementation of the Alternative Livelihood Programme in connection with the second island-wide octopus Fishing Closure in Rodrigues scheduled from 10th August to 09th October 2026.

- (vi) That the Commission for Information Technology will provide IP Transit capacity to Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to improve the quality of experience of internet services in Rodrigues at no additional cost.
- (vii) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will provide a stipend to each Rodriguan athlete who are participating in the Commonwealth Games 2026.
- (viii) To approve the participation of five local dancers and one choreographer in a one-week Inter- Island Intensive Dance Workshop organised by 'Le Studio' Dance School from 10th to 19th August 2026 in Mauritius.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) Of the award of contract for the supply, installation and commissioning of vertical multistage pumps at Mourouk and Riviere Coco Pumping Stations.
- (ii) That at its meeting held on Wednesday 24th July 2026, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of 15 (fifteen) Residential and four (4) Commercial Building and Land Use Permit.
- (iii) That the St Gabriel Livestock Production Unit proceeded with the sale of cattle for fattening and breeding purposes during the month of July 2026.
- (iv) Of the celebration of birthdays of Centenarians in recognition of their invaluable contributions to the social, cultural and historical development of Rodrigues.
- (v) Of the outcome of the 69th meeting of the Rodrigues Tourism Licensing Committee held on Tuesday 21st July 2026 whereby twenty (20) cases were considered.
