### **MAIN DECISIONS**

#### **Executive Council Meeting – Friday 05 June 2026**

**The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:**

#### **DECIDED**

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will proceed with the conversion of residential lease of applicants for Commercial/Industrial project as per list of applicants.
- (ii) To approve the proposed design for tourism project in the Tourism parcelling zone at Anse Ally and to allocate lots to some applicants thereof for Commercial/Industrial Projects for tourism activities.
- (iii) To approve that the Commission for Trade Licences extends the exemption of payment of Trade Licence fees for entrepreneurs/SMEs operating on a residential lease under the Home-Based Activity for an additional period of two (2) years.
- (iv) To approve that the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will proceed with the procurement and launching of bids for some polyethylene tank under the Rain Water Harvesting Scheme.
- (v) To approve that the Commission for Agriculture makes a request to the Registrar of Cooperatives for the appointment of a Caretaker Board for the reorganisation of the Cooperative Society Ltd situated at Citronelle.

- (vi) To approve "in principle" that the Commission for Agriculture proceeds with the provision of a grant to the *'Federation des Associations Cooperatives des Eleveurs Rodriguais'* (FACER) for the setting up of a Hatchery.
- (vii) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the implementation of the Proposed Action Plan to revert food insecurity in Rodrigues through immediate interventions aimed at strengthening local food production capacity and reducing dependency on imports in the agricultural and livestock sectors.
- (viii) That the Commission for Health will grant permission to a club to use the premises of the Grand La Fouche Corail Market for the holding of a Family Fun Day in collaboration with the Village Committee of Grand La Fouche Corail on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2026 as from noon.
- (ix) That the Commission for Family Welfare will proceed with the activities to be organised to celebrate the International Day of Families 2026 commemorated on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2026.
- (x) To approve the launching of Invitation for Proposals for selection of consultant (s) for capital projects under the Commission for Women's Affairs and others.
- (xi) That the Commission for Youth will provide a grant to the Rodrigues Regional Youth Council for the implementation of the Cultural training and Services of Cultural Youths/ Animators and Arts Instructors for the Empowerment of Youths and Artists in Rodrigues.
- (xii) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will proceed with the payment of accommodation for athletes, in connection with their participation in the Inter Colleges Sports Competition 2026 (athletics) in Mauritius.

- (i) Of the closing of bids for Component 1 of the Rodrigues Airport Project on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2026.

- (ii) That a delegation of the Procurement Policy Office (PPO) will be on mission to Rodrigues from 8<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> June 2026 to deliver training on e-Procurement System for bidders and officers of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly.
- (iii) That at its meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> June 2026, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of seventeen (19) Residential and one (1) Commercial Building and Land Use Permit.
- (iv) That the Rodrigues Public Utilities Corporation (RPUC) has initiated procurement proceedings for the re-bidding exercise for the implementation of 500m<sup>3</sup>/day desalination plant at Caverne Bouteille.
- (v) That the Commission for Child Development will proceed with the organization of activities to mark the Commemoration of the International Day of African Child 2026, under the *theme 'Ensuring universal access to water, sanitation and hygiene for every child in Africa'*, on 16<sup>th</sup> June at Port Sud Est Government School.
- (vi) Of the organization of an Essay Competition in the Creole language on the theme *'Memwar Nou Bann Gran Dimounn'* and the Call for Applications for Oral History, open to the public, in the context of the International Archives Day celebrated on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2026.
