



RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 21 August 2026

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) To approve the construction of a track road to facilitate access for households relocated from Ste Marie Village in the context of the Airport Development Project.
- (ii) To approve the launching of bid for the supply, installation and commissioning of a generator set, UPS and associated electrical works for the Rodrigues Court.
- (iii) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will grant permission to some applicants to pledge their leasehold rights in favour of their lending institutions.
- (iv) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will proceed with the necessary adjustments pertaining to the eligibility and prioritisation criteria to be applied in the assessment and processing of applications under the Rainwater Harvesting Scheme.
- (v) That the Commission for Training will publish the List of Indicative Priority field of studies for Rodrigues (2025 - 2028) which serves as a guiding framework to align education and human resource development with the economic, social and strategic needs of Rodrigues.

- (vi) That the Commission for Trade Licence will proceed with the issue of Trade Licences to some applicants, pending amendment and/or subletting of the leases as appropriate and will refer the case to the Cadastral Office for processing and finalisation of the appropriate commercial leases.
- (vii) To approve the further processing of some commercial and industrial projects on state land as well as on private land.
- (viii) That the Commission for Social Security will proceed with the provision of nappies, wipes and medical gloves to persons under and above 60 years with genuine hygiene-support needs in Rodrigues as per eligibility criteria.
- (ix) To approve that the Commission for Handicraft proceeds with the cultivation of vacoas plants on the plot of land situated at Montagne Goyaves which was initially allocated for the cultivation of Combava.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That the Honourable Dr Navinchandra RAMGOOLAM, GCSK, FRCP, Prime Minister of the Republic of Mauritius will be the Guest of Honour for the Celebration of 24th Anniversary of autonomy in Rodrigues on 12th October 2026.
- (ii) Of the holding of a Workshop on Food Observatory from 10 to 11 September 2026 in Rodrigues by the OR-ALIM following a survey on same which was carried by the organisation in 2025.
- (iii) That the Commission for Community Development will proceed with the inauguration of the Baie Malgache Community Centre on 04 September 2026.
- (iv) That the Commission for Education will proceed with the re-launching of bids for the:
 - (a) Construction of Four Additional Classrooms and Two Specialist Rooms at La Ferme College, Pistaches; and
 - (b) Renovation of Existing Buildings and Embellishment Works at Basile Allas Port Mathurin Government School, Port Mathurin.

- (v) That an Award Ceremony will be held on Wednesday 26 August 2026, in the Lecture Theatre of the Antoinette Prudence Human Resource Development Centre, to present NC3 Bakery Certificates to trainees who completed a Bakery Training Programme at Les Moulins de la Concorde Ltée in Mauritius.
- (vi) That the Licensing Committee has approved **sixteen (16)** applications for the issue of Trade Licence during its meeting held on Thursday 13 August 2026.
- (vii) That on Wednesday 26 August 2026, the Commission for Housing will proceed with the handing over of cheques to eligible beneficiary under the Government Grant for casting of Roof Slab Scheme and the Elderly Roof Slab Scheme.
