

RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 14 February 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will proceed with the parcelling of 20 new sites throughout Rodrigues for allocation of land to eligible applicants for residential and commercial purposes.
- (ii) To approve that the Commission for Agriculture will survey and issue Agricultural Permit on a region wise basis, starting at Camp Pintade.
- (iii) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Community Development will release the yearly financial grant of the Rodrigues Council of Social Services (RCSS) for the financial year 2024-2025.
- (iv) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Community Development will launch a Call for Proposals to support Community Based Organisations in implementing projects that contribute to community welfare and sustainable development.
- (v) That subject to clearance from the Chief Commissioner's Office (Commission for State Land) the Commission for Agriculture will provide financial assistance for the extension of low voltage CEB Network to a planter of Port Sud Est.

(vi) That the Commission for Handicraft will set up a pool of trainers to train aspiring artisans to create a vibrant, authentic and dynamic handicraft sector that showcases Rodriguan tradition and which produces high-quality handicraft products.

(vii) That the Commission for Arts and Culture in collaboration with the 'TrupSapsiway' will organise a one-week theatre workshop for local artists and a presentation of the play entitled 'Li' directed by

Mr. Gaston VALAYDEN in the context of the World Theatre Day 2025.

(viii) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will set up an Editing Committee to vet the draft booklet "*Rekey Romans Rodrige"*, which aims at safeguarding the oral tradition and cultural heritage of

Rodrigues.

TAKEN NOTE

(i) That the Commission for Agriculture is carrying out bidding exercise to purchase three (03) Water Lorries to supply water to Agricultural

Livestock Production Units and to planters and breeders.

(ii) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will organise a prize-giving ceremony for a poetry writing competition and will launch the CD 'Rekey Sega Tanbour Rodrig' in the context of the International Mother

Language Day on 21 February 2025.
