



RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 12th December 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Environment will proceed with the transfer of ownership of one (1) newly procured lorry from the Commission for Environment to Rodclean Company Ltd.
- (ii) To approve further processing of sixteen (16) applications of commercial and industrial projects and two (2) applications for land permit for small – scale commercial activities.
- (iii) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Vocational Training will provide financial assistance to one hundred and twenty (120) trainees enrolled in Hospitality courses to be run by the Polytechnics Mauritius and the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development.
- (iv) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will proceed with the disbursement of grant to the Rodrigues Public Utilities Corporation for the procurement of service kits for the HP 1254 booster pumps installed at English Bay and Pointe Coton desalination plants to ensure proper maintenance.

- (v) To approve the extension of CEB Network to the parcelised residential zones at Morcellement Petite Butte/Pointe Vinght Tours following requests for connection to electricity network from lessees who have been granted building sites thereat.
- (vi) To approve that the Commission for Agriculture proceeds with the revised fast track procedures for the renewal of Agricultural Permits.
- (vii) To approve the banning of importation of exotic birds to Rodrigues to prevent diseases and risk of birds escaping.
- (viii) That the Commission for Fisheries will initiate bidding exercise for the procurement and installation of mooring buoys in the region of Baie Aux Huitres and Baie Du Nord.
- (ix) That the Commission for Housing will disburse funding for the provision of housing assistance to some needy families for the construction of CIS – 2 Rooms with electrical materials under the Infrastructure Development for Needy Families Scheme.
- (x) To approve that the Commission for Tourism proceeds with the setting up of the Grant Steering Committee (GSC) for the Green Tourism Grants Scheme of the Rodrigues Airport Project.
- (xi) To approve that the Commission for Tourism proceeds with the recruitment of additional staff in the grade of Tourism Promotion Officer, Finance and Administrative Officer.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That according to results by the Mauritius Examination Syndicate the overall percentage pass rate for Rodrigues for Academic Year 2025 is 84.89% compared to 79.44% for Academic Year 2024 which represents an increase of 5.45% and out of 709 pupils of Grade 6 that were examined in the PSAC Assessment 601 have succeeded.
- (ii) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will proceed with the disbursement of fund in favour of the Rodrigues Public Utilities Corporation (RPUC) to meet operational costs for the months of October and November 2025.

- (iii) That at its meeting held on 9th December 2025, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of thirteen (13) Residential and one (1) Commercial Building and Land Use Permit.
- (iv) That the Commission for Health will provide internship to two (2) Rodriguan students as part of the requirements for the fulfilment of their studies in the health services in Rodrigues.
- (v) That the Commission for Health will proceed with the annual Celebration of Patients Day 2025 18th December 2025.
- (vi) That a team for the M6 Television Programme will be in Rodrigues on 13th December 2025 for a one-day filming project, which will highlight the Rodriguan culture, natural beauty, local experiences and promote tourism.
