



## **RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY**

### **MAIN DECISIONS**

#### **Executive Council Meeting – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2025**

**The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:**

#### **DECIDED**

- (i) That the Commission for State Land will issue clearance to the Central Electricity Board for the grant of electricity supply to applicants on State Land.
- (ii) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Community Development will release fund in favour of the Rodrigues Council of Social Services (RCSS) for financial year 2025/2026 for continued community-oriented projects while ensuring the smooth running of the organisation.
- (iii) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Environment will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Rodclean Ltd regarding the management of the Roche Bon Dieu Dumping Site.
- (iv) That the Commission for Education will provide a performance grant to each of the seventeen (17) primary schools for their outstanding performance at the PSAC Examinations 2025.

- (v) That the Commission for Industrial Development will proceed with the launching of the Technology Acquisition and Modernisation Scheme for Financial Year 2025/2026 targeting entrepreneurs in the food sector and provide a financial assistance to eligible entrepreneurs to enable them to acquire modern utensils and equipment.
- (vi) To approve that the Commission for Education will provide a sponsorship for postgraduate studies to an eligible applicant.
- (vii) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the revised quota for the exportation of livestock protocol to Mauritius for the period 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2026.
- (viii) That the Commission for Agriculture will proceed with the organisation of World Food Day 2025, namely the holding of an Agricultural Fair on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at Citronelle and the sale of meat at subsidized price on pork only.
- (ix) That the Commission for Fisheries will hire the services of a Fisheries Specialist to develop Terms of References (TOR) to request support from the Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) in the Fisheries Sector.
- (x) That the Commission for Housing will disburse funding for the provision of housing assistance to some needy families for the construction of a CIS-2/3 Rooms with electrical materials under the Infrastructure Development for Needy Families Scheme and a 50m<sup>2</sup> housing unit under the New Social Housing Scheme.

### **TAKEN NOTE**

- (i) Of the weather forecast for the month of January and February 2026.
- (ii) That the Commission for Public Infrastructure will proceed with the issue of Letter of Acceptance to a Contractor for the Upgrading of Jetty at Pointe Venus.
- (iii) That at its meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025, the Licensing Committee has approved ten (10) applications for the issue of Trade Licences.

- (iv) That according to last statistical records, 7,724 tourists visited Rodrigues during the month of September 2025, compared to 8,233 for September 2024. For the month of October 2025, there were 10,261 tourists compared to 9,961 for October 2024, which depicts an increase of 3.01%.
- (v) Of the Rodrigues Regional Youth Council (RYC) Election 2025 held on 6<sup>th</sup> December 2025 and the appointment of a new Executive Committee for the RYC for the 2025-2027 mandate.
