MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 7 November 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret Grandcourt, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land, will proceed with the fast track of the grant of state land lease for the setting up of religious places of worship to eligible applicants in Rodrigues.
- (ii) That the Chief Commissioner's Office proceeds with the setting up of a Communication/Public Relations Unit for the Rodrigues Regional Assembly, acting like the central communication hub, disseminating precise information on policies and activities and serving as interface between the RRA and the media.
- (iii) To approve the issue of Trade Licence, pending amendment of the leases as appropriate and to refer the cases to the Cadastral Office for processing and finalisation of the appropriate commercial leases.
- (iv) That the Commission for Trade Licences will adopt a policy regarding the documents to be submitted for the operation of a business activity in a commercial/industrial or private building, constructed prior to 2002.
- (v) To approve that the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Education proceeds with the launching of bids for the renovation and embellishment works at Terre Rouge and Basile Allas Government School.

- (vi) To approve the holding of a Medical Camp in Rodrigues by the Ahmadiyya Muslim Association in collaboration with the Humanity First Germany from 11th to 14th November 2024 in four (4) regions, namely La Ferme, Baie aux Huitres, Soupirs and Dans Bebe Community Centre.
- (vii) That the Commission for Health will proceed with the introduction of the productivity and reward concept of Units/Wards in the Health Services in Rodrigues once yearly as from Mid- November 2025 to encourage personal and professional growth, employee's motivation and patient's satisfaction.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) Of the upcoming technical mission of Officers of the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development on Performance-Based Budgeting (PBB) from 16th to 22nd November 2025, in connection with the introduction of the Performance-Based Budgeting in the Rodrigues Regional Assembly for Financial Year 2026-2027.
- (ii) Of the mission of the UNFPA and OutMoris Delegation, headed by Ms. Pricilla Li Ying, Head of Office, to Rodrigues from 9th to 12th December 2025.
- (iii) That at its meeting held on 30th October 2025, the Licensing Committee has approved nineteen (19) applications for the issue of Trade Licences.
- (iv) That the Commission for Public Infrastructure has issued letter of acceptance for consultancy services for the technical review and backup power design at the Public Infrastructure compound.
- (v) That the Commission for Health will offer a cash prize to the Men and Women Volleyball Teams for winning the 1st and 3rd place respectively in the volleyball festival organised by the Mauritius Police Force (Rodrigues Division) on 1st and 2nd November 2025 at Malabar Gymnasium.
- (vi) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will organise a series of Youth Caravan Awareness Campaign from 20th November to 14th December 2025 in the context of the Speciales Vacances 2025.
