MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 23 June 2023

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Johnson ROUSSETY, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Commission for Education will provide financial assistance to Marechal College and La Ferme College to organise study tours to Mauritius and Reunion Island respectively, as follows;
- 40 students of Grade 9 of Marechal College will proceed to Mauritius from 03 to 13 December 2023 to have an insight into the entrepreneurial sector in Mauritius by visiting different enterprises in various sectors such as hairdressing, biscuit making, and hotel as well as training institutions such as Lycée Agricole Saint Gabriel and Mauritius Institute of Training Development.
 - 27 Arts students of Grades 9 to 11 of La Ferme College will proceed to Reunion Island with the aims to increase the knowledge and techniques of art students through visits to places such as Ecole Supérieure des Beaux Arts, Lieu d'Art Contemporain de la Réunion and meeting with renowned artists.

- (ii) To approve the setting up of a web radio, as announced by the Chief Commissioner, in his Budget Speech for the Financial Year 2023/2024. The radio will emit from Queen Elizabeth Hospital through facebook to share and exchange information, provide update on development in the health sector and sensitize the population on health issues.
- (iii) That Commission for Fisheries will rehabilitate one IFAD boat which will be put at the disposal of the Marine Academy and Research Centre to conduct research, deploy, maintain and repair Fish Aggregating Devices in the off-lagoon and for the training of fishers.
