

RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 25 July 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will introduce new procedures with respect to new surveys carried out on private land in Rodrigues prior to registration of survey reports at the Registration Unit. The new procedures will take effect as from 1st October 2025.
- (ii) That the Commission for Health will provide return air tickets to three (3) adolescents to enable them to participate in T1 Diams Diabetes Camp and to attend therapeutic diabetes education in Mauritius from 3rd to 9th August 2025.
- (iii) To proceed with the activities to be organised to mark the 23rd Anniversary of the Autonomy as follows:
 - a) Unveiling of Plaque on "Miray Rekonesans" at the Alfred North Coombes Building Port Mathurin;
 - b) Reading of the Chief Commissioner's message in all educational institutions;
 - c) Messe d'action de grâce pour l'Autonomie at St Gabriel Cathedral;

- d) Official Ceremony and Conferment of *Médaille de la Reconnaissance Rodriguaise and Honorary Freemen* at Jean Daniel ANDRE, Camp du Roi Stadium;
- e) Final and Prize Giving Ceremony of the football match of the Rodrigues Day Cup "Female" at Jean Daniel ANDRE, Camp du Roi Stadium; and
- f) Final and Prize Giving Ceremony of the volleyball match of the Rodrigues Day Cup (Male) and (Female) at Malabar Gymnasium.
- (iv) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will grant permission to an event organiser to hold a concert at Mourouk Anse Enfer Football Ground on 31st August 2025.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Education in collaboration with the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate (MES) will conduct cascade-training workshops for secondary school educators of O, AS and A Level during school holidays from 28th July to 8th August 2025.
- (ii) That at its meeting held on Tuesday 22nd July 2025, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of ten (10) Residential Building and Land Use Permits.
- (iii) That the Commission for Health will disburse fund to "La Congregation des Filles de Marie de Saint Denis" to meet the management and operational costs of the Respite Care Centre at Piton.
- (iv) That the Commission for Health, Prison and Reform Institutions will proceed with future development projects at the Rodrigues Prison, Pointe La Gueule.
- (v) Of the outcome of the mission led by Mr Jean Alain Wong SO, Commissioner for Tourism and others and the Departmental Head of the Commission from 13th to 16th July 2025 in Mauritius.

- (vi) Of the submission of the Quarterly Report for the period April to June 2025, depicting all the promotional and marketing activities organised by Discovery Rodrigues Co. Ltd for the fourth quarter of financial year 2024/2025.
- (vii) That the Commission for Youth and Sports in collaboration with the Rodrigues Regional Youth Council (RRYC) and the Rodrigues Youth Council Against Drugs (RYCAD) is organising a one-day activity to mark the International Youth Day on Saturday 16th August 2025 at the Baladirou Youth Residential and Training Centre.
- (viii) Of the results of the inter-college games held in Mauritius from 14th to 18th July 2025, which yielded an impressive medal haul of 45 medals, comprising of twenty-eight (28) Gold, thirteen (13) Silver and four (4) Bronze. The Ananias Andre Le Chou College earned the prestigious Best College Award in the 18+ category.
