

RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 30 May 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Franceau Aubret GRANDCOURT, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office will submit its no objection to the Prime Minister's Office to declare the Cattle Pen and the Quay Area of Port Mathurin as Restricted Areas.
- (ii) That the Commission for Agriculture will sponsor the issuance of Planters, Breeders and Agro-processor Cards to eligible small-scale farmers, livestock breeders and agro-processors through the Small Farmers Welfare Fund (SFWF).
- (iii) To approve in principle that the Commission for Agriculture through the Tractor Subsidy Scheme will:
 - (a) provide financial assistance up to Rs 250,000 to each four (4) eligible Agricultural Cooperatives and four (4) eligible planters through the DBM for the purchase of a tractor; and
 - (b) disburse a sum of Rs 2 M to the Development Bank of Mauritius (DBM) Ltd which will provide a loan of Rs 250,000 to top-up the cost of one tractor (Rs 500,000) to eligible Agricultural Cooperatives.

(iv) That in the context of the celebration of the World Ocean Day 2025, the Commission for Fisheries and the Marine Academy and Research Centre will launch sensitization campaigns in primary schools as from the second week of June 2025.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That a team from the European Union (EU) delegation headed by Mr Jose Maria TRONCOSO PERERA, Head of Cooperation, will be on mission to Rodrigues to carry out a technical monitoring session from 11th to 13th June 2025.
- (ii) That at its meeting held on Tuesday 30th May 2025, the Building and Land Use Permit Committee has approved the grant of ten (10) Residential Building and Land Use Permits.
- (iii) That two (2) delegations from the Mauritius Sports Council (MSC) will be on mission to Rodrigues in June 2025 for the evaluation of the National Certificate level 2 (NC2) in Technical and to hold talks on Yoplait/Candia Sports Medicine in primary and secondary schools.
