

RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 06 June 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Deputy Chief Commissioner, Mr. Johnson ROUSSETY, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Industrial Development will provide financial assistance to a group of eight (8) entrepreneurs in handicrafts and others to proceed with an exchange programme in Madagascar from 12th to 21st June 2025.
- (ii) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Water Resources will award contract for the procurement of six (6) water tankers.
- (iii) To approve that the Rodrigues Public Utilities Corporation (RPUC) will allocate contract for the construction of the Primary Potable Water Supply Network Phase 1 (Pointe Coton to Petit Brûlé Reservoir) to Tianli Construction Ltd.
- (iv) That the Commission for Housing will set up the "Rodrigues Housing Monitoring Committee" and the "Rodrigues Slab Monitoring Committee" with a view to ensure that the two schemes are properly being administered and achieved.
- (v) That the Commission for Housing will provide assistance to three families for the completion and construction of their houses.

- (vi) That the Commission for Child Development will provide a financial support to SEN Schools in view of the commemoration of the International Day of African Child 2025 observed every 16th June each year.
- (vii) That the Commission for Employment will proceed with the organisation of basic training course and placement in favour of fifteen (15) beneficiaries/jobseekers under the Employment Relief Programme (ERP) for Financial Year 2024 - 2025 from July to mid-August 2025 in the field of Elementary Hairdressing by the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD).

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) That the Acting Director of the Office of Public Sector Governance will lead a delegation to Rodrigues from 8th to 14th June 2025 to assist the Rodrigues Regional Assembly's Commissions in setting up their Audit Committees and to conduct training for its members.
- (ii) That the English-Speaking Union in collaboration with the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Education, the US Embassy and the Mauritius Commercial Bank will conduct the Spelling Bee and Story Telling Competition on 12th and 13th June 2025.
- (iii) That the Licensing Committee at its meeting held on 22nd May 2025 has approved sixteen (16) applications for the issue of Trade Licence.
- (iv) That the Commission for Housing will organise a ceremony for the handing over of cheques to beneficiaries of Government Grant for Casting/Recasting of Roof Slab Scheme on Friday 6th June 2025 at the Conference Room of the Central Administration.
- (v) That the Commission for Housing will launch an expression of interest for a Service Provider in the field of Civil Engineering to assess structure of housing units for the re-casting of slab.
- (vi) That the Commission for Prison and Reforms Institution will launch an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the Rental of Building to host a Probation Home for Girls and Probation Hostel for Boys in Rodrigues.

- (vii) That the Commission for Child Development in collaboration with the Mauritius Red Cross Society is organising a 3-day workshop on first aid for child day care centres and the Foyer Marie Madeleine de la Croix of Baladirou for Child Day Care Managers and Care Givers.
- (viii) That in the context of the implementation of "Empowering Women Entrepreneurs in Rodrigues Programme, the Commission for Women in collaboration with SME Mauritius will organise training session entitled "Start Your Business" from 5th June to 20th for eighty-four (84) women entrepreneurs.
- (ix) Of the outcome of the 56th Meeting of the Rodrigues Tourism Licensing Committee (RTLC) which was held on Tuesday 27th May 2025, whereby twenty-six (26) cases were considered and processed.
- (x) Of the participation of Rodrigues in the 11th Edition of the International Tourism Exhibition of Madagascar (ITM) which will take place in Antananarivo from 12th to 15th June 2025.
- (xi) That the Commission for Arts and Culture will meet the cost of return air tickets of two local artists to participate in two Cultural Exchange Programme in Mauritius.
- (xii) That in view to mark the World Music Day 2025, the Commission for Arts and Culture will organise an all-day music concert (open stage) on 21st June at Port Mathurin as from 10.00 hrs.
- (xiii) Of the activities to be organised by the Commission for Youth and Sports in collaboration with the Mauritius Recreation Council from 6th to 7th June in Rodrigues :
 - (a) National Yoga Campaign on 6th June in Malabar Gymnasium at 16.00 hrs;
 - (b) "Lwazir san Barrier" project for "People with Disabilities" on 7th June at Baladirou Youth Residential and Training Centre at 09.00 hrs; and
 - (c) Cultural Animation for Youth on 7th June at English Bay Youth and Family Centre at 15.00 hrs.
