

RODRIGUES REGIONAL ASSEMBLY

MAIN DECISIONS

Executive Council Meeting – Friday 20 June 2025

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Deputy Chief Commissioner, Mr. Johnson ROUSSETY, G.O.S.K; and has among its deliberations:

DECIDED

- (i) That the Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for State Land will review criteria for pledging of leasehold rights for housing loans.
- (ii) To approve the release of additional funds to meet the operational costs of the Rodrigues Public Utilities Corporation (RPUC) for the months of March, April, May and June 2025.
- (iii) That the Deputy Chief Commissioner's Office, Commission for Public Infrastructure will grant permission to the Team RC Motorsports for the organization of the "RODRIGUES MOB TOUR 2025" in collaboration with the Motor Club and Port Mathurin United North Sports Club from 10th to 13th July 2025.
- (iv) To approve the revised protocol for exportation of livestock from Rodrigues to Mauritius, along with a revised Agreement with the Traders to be effective from 1st July 2025, following the Cabinet Decision of 9th May 2025.

- (v) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will provide financial assistance to athletes who sustained serious injuries during the 4eme Jeux de Rodrigues Sports Competition.
- (vi) To approve that the Commission for Youth and sports will grant permission to an event organiser for the organisation of a concert at Mourouk Anse Enfer football ground on 30th August 2025.
- (vii) That the Commission for Youth and Sports will provide financial assistance to Grand Baie Albatross Sports Club to participate in a friendly tour in Mauritius in July 2025.

TAKEN NOTE

- (i) Of the Rodrigues Regional Assembly Segregation and Collection of Waste Regulations 2025 passed in the Regional Assembly on 10th of June to be effective as from 1st January 2026. The Regulations aim at promoting segregation of wastes and to have a better waste management system in line with the vision of making Rodrigues an ecological island.
- (ii) That the Commission for Child Development and others will collaborate with PEDOSTOP (a non-governmental organisation) based in Mauritius for a continuous training programme targeting Child Protection Professionals such as staff of the Child Development Unit (CDU), Shelter, Psychologists and Social Workers.
