MAIN DECISIONS

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING - FRIDAY 02 JULY 2021

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of Mr. Nicolson LISETTE, Deputy Chief Commissioner

- 1. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Prison and Reforms Institutions undertakes additional works at the Rehabilitation Youth Centre at Oyster Bay so that the centre could accommodate girl inmates.
- 2. The Executive Council has approved that the criteria for eligibility for the allocation of the Post Graduate Medical Scholarships Scheme for academic year 2021/2022 be reviewed and be open to all medical practitioners on the Rodrigues establishment reckoning at least two (2) years of experience.
- 3. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Sports proceeds with:
 - i. the construction of a boundary fence at Pointe Mapou Motocross Circuit;
 - ii. the construction of nine (9) *Pétanque* grounds around Rodrigues; and
 - iii. the setting up of a Badminton Training School in collaboration with the Rodrigues Regional Badminton Committee at Daflorence Edouard Gymnasium at Le Chou College.

- 4. The Executive Council has taken note that 314 State Land Leases will be issued during the month of July 2021.
- 5. The Executive Council has taken note that a Works Order has been issued for the construction of an access road to Anse Femie and a box culvert at Papayes.
- 6. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Water Resources will award a contract for the Construction of 1000m³ Concrete Circular Reservoir at Montagne Goyaves.
- 7. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Education is launching a bidding exercise for the upgrading of playgrounds at Anse Quitor and Montagne Goyaves Community Schools and Terre Rouge and Marc Etienne Roche Bon Dieu Government Schools.
- 8. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Health provides financial support to CRAC Anti-Drug Group for the implementation of prevention programmes against substance abuse in Rodrigues from July to September 2021.
- 9. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Agriculture launches a procurement exercise for the feasibility study for a Cold Storage facility in Rodrigues to store onions and other locally produced crops.
- 10. The Executive Council has taken note of the activities being organised to mark the International Cooperative Day on Saturday 03 July 2021 on the theme "Rebuild Better Together".

An official ceremony will be held on Saturday 03 July 2021 and a workshop will be organised with representatives of Cooperative Societies by the end of July 2021.

- 11. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Education will proceed with the distribution of Education and Sports Kits to all Grade 1 pupils of Primary schools as from Tuesday 06 July 2021.
- 12. The Executive Council has taken note that the new Pre-primary School at Jardin Mamzelle will be inaugurated on Friday 09 July 2021.
