EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING - FRIDAY 07 MAY 2021

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Louis Serge CLAIR, GCSK

1. The Executive Council has taken note of the school calendar for academic year 2021/2022:

- 2. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Education provides an additional grant to the "Association des Ecoles Maternelles de Rodrigues (AEMR)" to meet the cost for:
 - a. the revision of salaries in favour of the staff of the association; and
 - b. the recruitment of eight (8) additional teachers and two (2) additional helpers for the new academic year 2021/2022 due to the increase in school population.

A meeting will be held with the association to explain the modalities thereof.

- 3. The Executive Council has taken note of the celebration of three (3) 100th birthdays during the month of May 2021:
 - a. Mrs. Regina MARIANNE of Dans Samy on 12th May 2021;
 - b. Mrs. Marie Elisabeth LOUIS RAVINA of Dans Bébé on 13th May 2021; and
 - c. Mrs. Lydie PERRINE of Camp du Roi on 29th May 2021.
- 4. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for State Land will issue 282 state land leases during the month of May 2021.
- 5. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Education provides a financial grant in favour of Parent Teacher Associations (PTA) of all Primary Schools for the procurement of teaching tools and pedagogical materials for pupils for the academic year 2021/2022.
- 6. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Family Welfare organises a symposium on the theme "Protection de son enfant au sein de la cellule familiale" to commemorate the International Day of Families on 15 May 2021 at the Cultural and Leisure Centre, Mon Plaisir.
- 7. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Family Welfare provides a financial assistance to 16 beneficiaries under the Family Farm Project.
- 8. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Agriculture launches an Alternative Livelihood Programme for farmers whose farming activities are being impacted by the Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) Outbreak in Rodrigues.
- 9. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Education is launching bids for waterproofing works at Mont Lubin College.
- 10. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Public Infrastructure is initiating bidding procedures for the Construction of an additional 30km Track Roads including Footpaths and Other Civil Works in Rodrigues.
- 11. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Information and Communication Technology will organise the Web Cup Regional 2021 from 29 to 30 May 2021 at the ICT Centre for Excellence.

- 12. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Library Services has awarded a contract for the construction of a gate post and a toilet at the "Centre de Lecture et d'Animation Culturelle (CLAC)" at Grande Montagne.
- 13. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Sports has awarded a contract for the upgrading of Roseaux Football Ground.
