## MAIN DECISIONS

## **EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING - FRIDAY 23 APRIL 2021**

## The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Louis Serge CLAIR, GCSK

- The Executive Council has taken note of the arrangements being made for another batch of 126 residents of Rodrigues to proceed to quarantine on or about 28<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and 04<sup>th</sup> May 2021 respectively. At as date, there are 129 residents already in quarantine in Mauritius and 60 residents in quarantine in Rodrigues.
- 2. As announced by the Chief Commissioner in his Budget Speech for Financial year 2021/2022, the Executive Council has approved the modalities for additional subsidies on animal feeds in Rodrigues with a view to provide lower prices on the market to breeders and ultimately to consumers. The new prices will be effective as from Monday 10 May 2021.
- 3. The Executive Council has taken note of the status of the Foot and Mouth Disease Outbreak (FMD) in Rodrigues. The Commission for Agriculture has strengthened sero-surveillance around the island.
- 4. The Executive Council has agreed that the Commission for Education provides a financial grant to Parent Teacher's Associations (PTA) of all Primary Schools and Special Education Needs (SEN) Schools for the organisation of Educational Inland Outings for all pupils of Grade 5 and SEN Schools during April to June 2021.
- 5. The Executive Council has agreed that the Commission for Education provides an Educational and sports kit to Grade 1 pupils of all Primary Schools. 1,060 pupils who will join Grade 1 for the academic year 2021/2022 will receive each a kit.

- 6. The Executive Council has agreed to review the costing of housing units being constructed under the Infrastructure Development to Needy Families and Elderly Housing Scheme.
- 7. The Executive Council has agreed that the Commission for Arts and Culture extends the course Music in Theory in Practice Grade 1 run by the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music (ABRSM) from the United Kingdom to youth bands in Rodrigues.
- 8. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Education is launching bids for Waterproofing and Repair Works at Marechal College and Terre Rouge College.
- 9. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Prisons and Reforms Institutions has awarded a contract for the construction of a boundary wall and lighting structure at the Rodrigues Prison.
- 10. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Social Security has awarded a contract for the construction of a rainwater harvesting structure at Montagne du Sable under the GCCA+ Climate Smart Agriculture Project.
- 11. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Sports has launched bids for the upgrading of football grounds at Citron Donis, Mt Cabris Corail, Reposoir and Camp Pintade.
- 12. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Sports in Collaboration with the Rodrigues Fitness and Wellness Association is organising a Yoga Festival on Saturday 24 April 2021 from 09.00 to 15.00 hours at Daflorence Edouard Gymnasium at Le Chou College.
