MAIN DECISIONS

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING - FRIDAY 30 APRIL 2021

The Executive Council met today under the chairmanship of the Chief Commissioner, Mr. Louis Serge CLAIR, GCSK

1. The Executive Council has taken note of the arrangements being made for a batch of 121 residents of Rodrigues to proceed to quarantine on or about Wednesday 05 and Monday 10 May 2021 respectively. At as date, there are three batches comprising 192 residents in quarantine in Mauritius.

Two batches of passengers will be repatriated to Rodrigues on Tuesday 04 and Thursday 06 May 2021 subject to all COVID-19 tests being negative.

The Executive Council has also taken note that first batch of 60 passengers who were repatriated to Rodrigues on 18 April 2021 have left quarantine on Monday 26 April 2021 after all COVID-19 tests were revealed negative.

- 2. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Child Development organises a series of workshops on Prevention of Child Grooming and Sexual Abuse targeting girls from different educational and vocational institutions as from Wednesday 05 May 2021.
- 3. The Executive Council has approved that a capital grant will be provided to Discovery Rodrigues Co. Ltd. for the implementation of the project "Design, Fabrication and Fixing of Signage in villages and public beaches". The project will also comprise the marking of 5 hiking paths around Rodrigues.
- 4. The Executive Council has approved that the Commission for Tourism provides a one-off financial assistance to the Rod Trail Association (RTA) for the organisation of the Port Mathurin Urban Trail (PMUT) 2021 Edition which will be held on Sunday 09 May 2021 at Port Mathurin.

- 5. The Executive Council has taken note of the outcome of the 20th meeting of the Rodrigues Tourism Licensing Committee (RTLC) held on Friday 23 April 2021.
- 6. The Executive Council has taken note that arrangements are being made for the extension of Central Electricity Board (CEB) Network to the new parcelised zone at Pointe Vingt Tours and for the extension of low-voltage network for the installation of street lightings.
- 7. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Labour and Industrial Relations will organise a series of sensitisation programmes in the context of the World Day for Safety and Health at Work 2021.
- 8. The Executive Council has taken note that the Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity will provide anti-influenza vaccines for the vaccination campaign 2021 for the elderly in Rodrigues.
- 9. The Executive Council has taken note that the Commission for Sports will initiate procurement procedures for the construction of Cloakroom at La Ferme and Baie Lascars.
